Presentations and Public Meetings

Mayor's Address

Mayor Nicholson noted his attendance at eight meetings and events since the last council meeting. Highlights of the address include:

- In a meeting with the Executive Assistant to our MPP, Township priorities were discussed including Water and Wastewater affordability in Cobden, specifically the Water and Wastewater Task Force recommendations, and continued advocacy efforts with the Ministry of Infrastructure for funding.
- The Beachburg Fair Volunteer Appreciation BBQ, attended with Councillor Tabbert, was a great event and it was noted the Field to Fibre event was a great success, we look forward to seeing this event annually.
- In a meeting with the English Public School Board representatives, including the Director of Community Services for the County of Renfrew, discussion around how to bring a not-for-profit provider to our Region to provide full-time, as well as before and after school, childcare was informative, and work continues to achieve this.

Office of the CAO

Council enacted a by-law to appoint a new member to the Whitewater Region Public Library Board. The current board members include Cindy McAllister, Monica La Grotta, Angela Butterworth, Jim Butterworth, Mary Clark and now Dr. Jamal Hejazi. Councillor Connie Tabbert serves as a council appointed member. Council approved the use of internet and telephone voting and optical scanning vote tabulators for the 2026 Municipal Election.

Council received the final Water and Wastewater Task Force report which can be found on the Township's website at <u>www.whitewaterregion.ca/services/water-wastewater-services/</u> and directed staff to include key recommendations in the 2025 departmental workplan.

Some of the recommendations within the report are already being implemented. Key immediate recommendations include enhancing public education, improving communication during water-related incidents, creating by-laws, exploring alternative funding options and investigating rate structures and classes.
