

Rapid Road Construction Notice

Project Description

The Township of Whitewater Region will be starting construction on Rapid Road between from Gore line (CR-50) to Gratton Trail. The primary project scope is to place a new single surface treatment to the existing double treatment surface (DST) to extend the life expectancy of Rapid Road. Township staff will be completing the following items prior to the preventative maintenance of the single surface.

- Removal of some existing DST to eliminate heavily pothole and distressed areas
- Sweeping and removing excess high shoulders
- Minor ditching along Timm and Rapid Road
- Five culvert replacements

Project Result and Timing

Construction is anticipated to begin on Tuesday July 23rd and be completed by the end of August.

Funding

The Council of the Township of Whitewater Region has included the resurfacing of Rapid Road in the 2024 Budget, funded by the Ontario Community Infrastructure Fund (OCIF).

Road Closure and Traffic

No road closures are anticipated during the construction project, but traffic delays can be expected as lane closures and flagging operations will take place daily.
