RE: Beachburg Drinking Water System Boil Water Advisory

Whitewater Region, Ontario – January 2, 2025

A boil water advisory has been issued for the Beachburg Drinking Water System by the Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) due to a loss of system pressure caused by a watermain break.

Water system users in the Village of Beachburg are advised to bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute prior to using it for domestic purposes (e.g. drinking, making infant formula and juice, brushing teeth, washing raw foods, and making ice). A boil water advisory fact sheet is available on both the Renfrew County and District Health Unit and Township websites.

The Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) isolated the watermain break and repair crews have been dispatched to repair the watermain. The boil water advisory will remain in place until rescinded by RCDHU once two consecutive sets of samples are taken 24 hours apart that produce negative results.

The Township in collaboration with the Ontario Clean Water Agency is working with the Renfrew County and District Health Unit regarding the boil water advisory. Further updates will be provided through the Township's website and social media channels.
