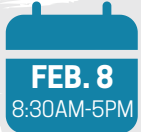

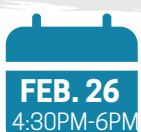

ALL 2024 BURN PERMITS HAVE EXPIRED

All owners who wish to set or maintain a fire in the Township of Whitewater Region must first obtain a permit. Permits are valid through the calendar year in which they are issued and expire on December 31st of that year. Special/Agricultural burns require a site visit by the Fire Chief or designate for approval. Apply for your burn permit at www.burnpermits.com.

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANTS

As part of the 2025 budget, Council approved \$15,000 to support the Township's Community Improvement Plan (or CIP for short). What's a CIP? It's a program that allows the municipality to issue grants for private property improvements, with the goals of encouraging investment into our community, enhancing our agricultural sector, and improving the health of our watershed. We have two categories of grants:

VILLAGE & HAMLET BEAUTIFICATION

This program aims to enhance the look and feel of our villages and hamlets and remove barriers to access businesses and gathering spaces. Grants are available for projects that improve a building's façade, support accessibility, improve property grounds and landscaping, and enhance your business' signage.

For more information on these programs and to determine if your project is eligible for a grant, you can view the brochures for each program on our website by scanning the QR code or contact Rebecca Gill, Community Development Coordinator at 613-646-2282 (ext. 129). Projects are reviewed and awarded on a rolling basis.

ENVIRONMENTAL & AGRICULTURAL ENHANCEMENT

This program aims to improve the health of our watershed and to support the agricultural sector in our community. Grants are available for projects such as on-farm diversified or agricultural-related uses, agricultural buffers, cattle fencing, brownfield rehabilitation, septic system improvements, and shoreline restoration.



COMMUNITY RECREATION GRANT

The Spring intake for the Community Recreation Grant has begun. The Community Recreation grant is designed to support community partners providing programs and recreation services to the residents of the Township of Whitewater Region. PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT PLANS

Did you know the Township of Whitewater Region offers pre-authorized payment plans for Property Taxes and Water/Sewer Bills? There are many benefits:

- You don't have to write a cheque
- No waiting in line to make a payment
- You will save on postage and transportation
- You don't need to keep track of due dates
- No penalties for missing a due date

CREDIT CARD ONLINE PAYMENTS

Now available with VISA, Mastercard, or VISA Debit. See the Website for the link. Processing fees charged by Paymentus are applied to all transactions. Please allow a minimum of 3 business days for online payments for:

- Water/Sewer
- Property Tax
- Accounts Receivable

AFTER HOURS DROP BOX

Place your payments in the Drop Box located at the front door of the Municipal Office. If you require a receipt, please indicate that with your payment along with your email address or mailing address for the receipt to be sent to you.

ONLINE BANKING PAYMENTS

Payments for Property Taxes, Utility Bills, and Accounts Receivable can be made at your bank or online. Please allow a minimum of 3 business days for online payments. For online banking, search payee:

Whitewater Region Taxes, Whitewater Region Water, Whitewater Region AR.

Please note that for online banking, you will need to enter your roll #/account for each property separately with modifications.

- For tax payments, a 15-digit account is required
- For water payments, an 11-digit account is required

Example: Roll # 4758-051-045-21000.0000, enter the following:

Taxes: 475805104521000
Water: 05104521000

Please make note of the above due dates. If paying online or by credit card, please ensure payment is made at least 3 business days before the due date to avoid additional charges.
